

**RULES & REGULATIONS
FOR THE USE OF THIS
KEILIM MIKVAH**

- 1 All clean utensils should be immersed completely under water. Stickers should usually be removed prior to immersion. Moisten hands in mikvah water & loosely grip utensil, or use the handled-container provided. Gently shake utensil underwater to insure utensil becomes completely wet.
- 2 The following Bracha (ברכה) should be recited immediately before immersion: (For a single item, replace the concluding phrase with על מבילת בלי.)

ברוך אתה י-הוה
אלהינו מלך העולם
אשר קדשנו במצותיו וצונו
על מבילת כלים

*Baruch atah ado-nai, elo-hainu melech ha'olam,
asher kidishanu b'mitzvosav v'tzivanu,
al tevillas keilim. (for many items)
-or-
al tevillas keili. (for one item)*

- 3 **Whatever you bring with you, you should take with you.**
This includes ALL wrappings, paper, boxes and labels.

- 4 **Children should never be left unattended inside this room.**

Besides the concern for child safety, there's no assurance that the tevillah process has been done properly by someone pre-bar/bas mitzvah.

- 5 **A modest donation of \$1.00 per visit is requested**

A tzedaka box is available for this purpose.

- 6 **Before you leave, please dry all countertops.**

- 7 **Please insure the door is closed & locked behind you.**
